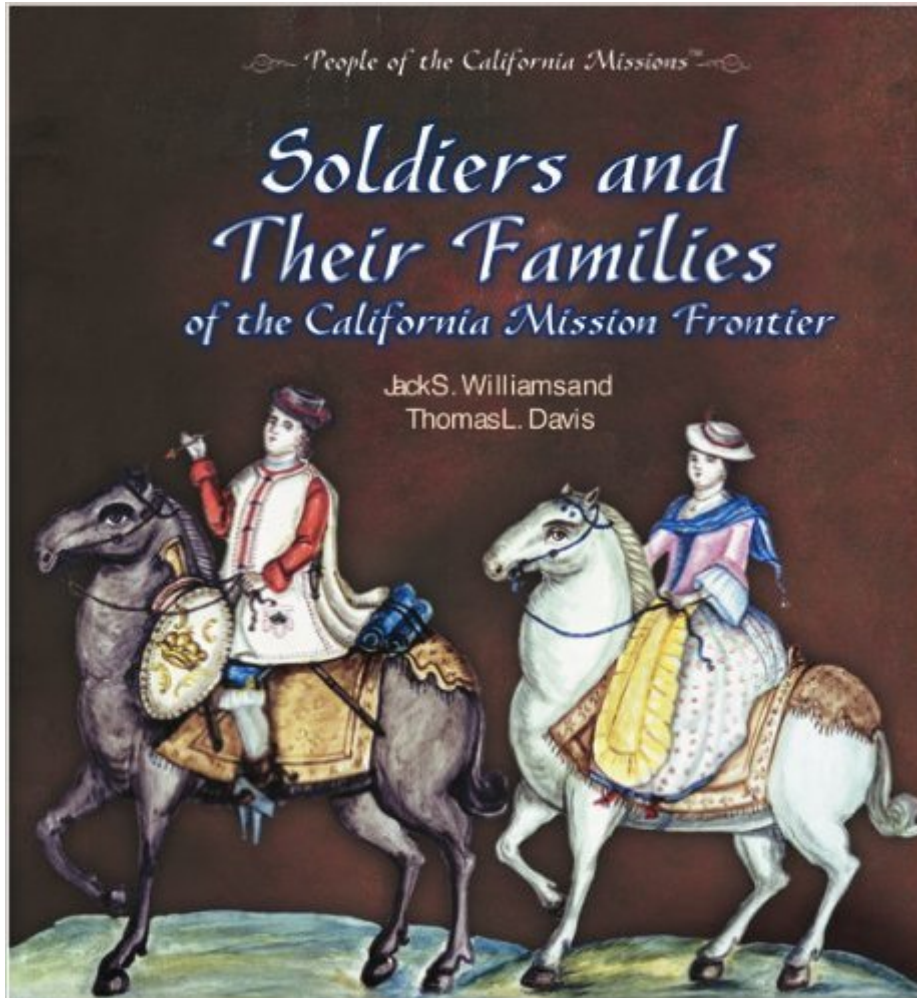


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Soldiers And Their Families (People Of The California Missions)
