

Monsters Do Not Know Tae Kwan Do is a humorous look at how to deal with those pesky creatures of the night. The narrator tells readers that âœeven if they are slimy or really rough. Even if they are pretty tough. If I wake up, I shouldn't worry. If I wake up I shouldn't hurry. Because thereâ™s one thing that I know. Monsters do not know Tae Kwan Do.â •As a mom of four, I have had my share of sleepless nights courtesy of the elusive monsters hiding in the closets and under the beds. This books empowers children by finding one area monsters are lacking and magnifying

this skill in the children. It is a clever and well written story that is a must read at bedtime or anytime! I highly recommend picking up a copy of Monsters Do Not Know Tae Kwan Do.

The story revolves around two small girls who live in a room that is inhabited by... MONSTERS! But they're not afraid because they know Tae Kwon Do! It's a story of empowerment, and standing up for yourself (but rest assured, mom and dad, it's not violent at all). Both of my nieces take kid-martial arts and they identify with the two main girls, talking while they're reading it about which illustrated girl is which. The story is simple, linear, very well illustrated, and easy for young ones to follow... and to be done in less than ten minutes, right in time for bed. And not to worry, the monsters in the book aren't too scary (more *Where the Wild Things Are* than anything that would give the little ones nightmares). Strongly recommend.

I wanted to get my daughter a book about tae kwon do and I liked the premise of this one. However, both the rhyming text and the illustrations were not of the quality I expected. I found it boring. It was quite short, with very little to it. If I had seen it before buying I would not have purchased it.

My son is 4 and takes tae kwon do, he was also having some bad monster dreams, this was perfect, and worked very well. Now whenever he thinks about Monsters he says "Monsters don't know Tae kwon do" and that's the end of that.

Bought this for my 5 year old starting Kindergarten in September as part of her school's summer reading list. She will be 6 years in January. She liked the book. Not a favorite though. I loved the concept as well. But, I think the story is too simplistic for her age group.

My daughter (7 yrs), a current green belt in taekwondo, absolutely loves this cute book. She was having issues with fear of monsters in her room and I saw this book and jumped right on it to buy a copy. Very cute story, great illustrations and overall great read for those little ones who struggle to overcome a fear of the monster under their bed or in the closet. Now she knows that monsters do not know taekwondo but she does and she's no longer afraid.
