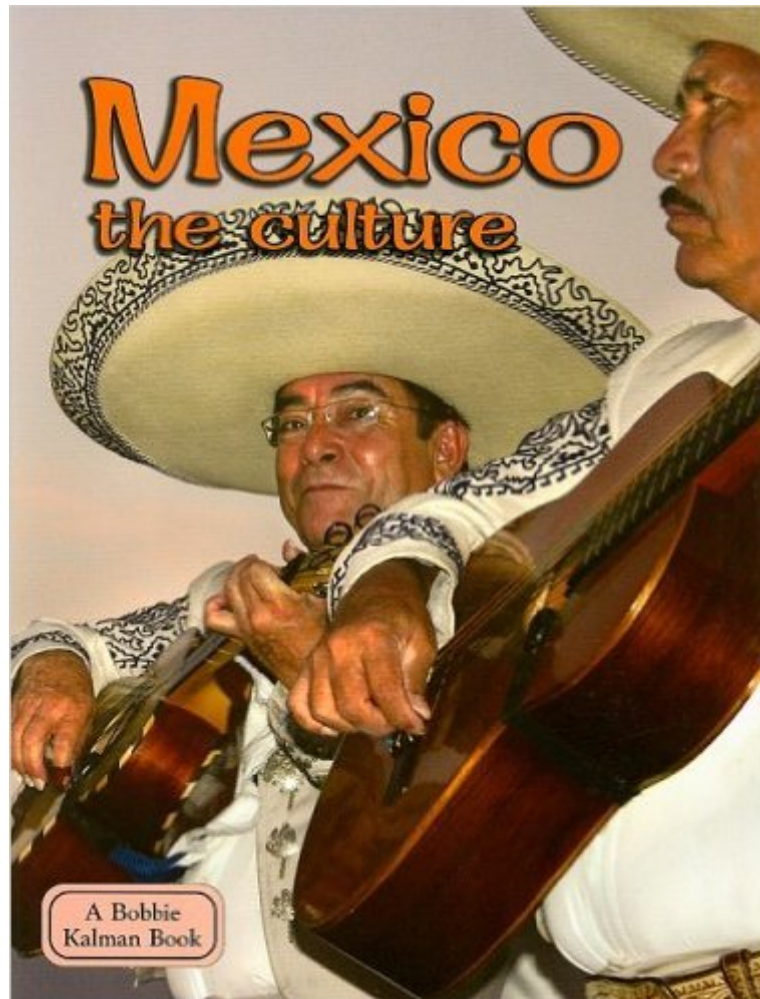

The books provide a good mix of geography, history, scenery, customs, food, religious holidays, music, food, etc. Good photos, and the writing is strong enough to be of interest to adults but not so heavy that it chases away middle school or high school readers.
