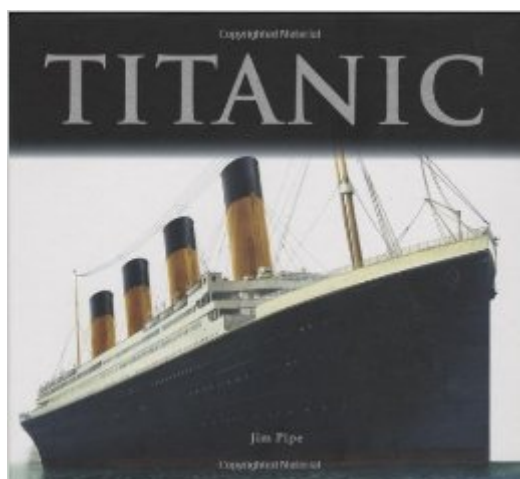

Synopsis

A meticulously reconstructed adventure of a legendary journey. The doomed maiden voyage of the Titanic nearly a hundred years ago affected all levels of society. Titanic is a large-format, fully illustrated, hands-on expedition through the ship itself. It tells the story of the sailing experience and the tragic end. The text is written from the viewpoint of a journalist narrator on board for the maiden voyage. Throughout the book, this story comes to life with precise reproductions of printed items from the period, such as: Tickets Postcards Newspaper clippings Telegrams Official technical data Envelopes and letters Certificate of seaworthiness ... and more. The narrator journalist visits every area of the ship, describing little-known facts and revealing details often missed. For example, not everyone knows that the Titanic's fourth funnel was only a hollow fake intended solely to make the ship look bigger and appear faster. The journalist's tour leads to the bridge just when disaster strikes. Then the tone changes from simple wonder to growing horror. The narrator's imaginary account is combined with actual eyewitness accounts of the sinking, including those by surviving children. The aftermath of the tragedy that took 1,500 lives is covered and includes the reports and inquiries of the official investigation. Titanic is a richly detailed and dramatic interactive experience for readers of all ages.

So in addition to presenting information about the ship, it's voyage, and it's demise, you also get a (fictional) first person narrative about the voyage. One item to note: This book contains a number of smaller pieces of paper contained within pockets in the book. I'd recommend this book for older children that will be able to keep these pieces with the book, lest they get lost.

This is a big book and has great information without being overwhelming. The book has great features like a "Sea Life Guide" and a menu that can be pulled out, and a newspaper clipping from the Titanic's sinking, among other things. It's a very interactive book. All my kids really enjoy it. I thought it was especially nice because it was a good price. I highly recommend this book.

Throughout the book, there are replicas of Titanic Memorabilia. A ticket to ride on the Titanic can be found within the book, playing cards that passengers played with can be seen, the schematic of the book can be found inside, etc. This is a hands-on book that contains bits and pieces of history that can be removed from the book and held by the reader. I would not recommend this book to be viewed and enjoyed alone by children under eight or nine. It contains many extra pieces that could be lost or ruined.
